Changing Me

- Who to ask for help if they are worried or frightened

Future Learning Links:

Key Facts/Information:

- Children are introduced to life cycles eg. frog and compare with the Human life cycle.
- They discuss changes so far in their bodies and the correct names for private body parts (safeguarding duty of schools).
- Children are taught that nobody has the right to hurt private parts.
- They look at how to manage feelings and access help if they are worried.
