Drawing	<ul> <li>Use a variety of drawing tools – crayon, chalk, pencil, felt tips, poster paint</li> <li>Draw light and dark lines (tone)</li> <li>Create rubbings (texture)</li> <li>Observe and draw shapes</li> <li>Observe and draw patterns</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Experiment with tools and surfaces – oil pastels, chalks, pencils, colouring pencils, poster paint – on the playground, fabrics, paper, wood (texture and pattern)</li> <li>Draw lines from observations</li> <li>Draw the gaps (shapes in between objects)</li> </ul>

Sculpture	<ul> <li>Roll, carve, knead and make marks on malleable materials – dough, clay</li> <li>Use malleable materials to make objects for a purpose – 2D</li> <li>Use patterns</li> <li>Use natural materials to create individual land art pieces</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Explore sculpture of malleable materials</li> <li>Manipulate malleable materials for a purpose – 3D Mod Rock</li> <li>Add detail and texture to model</li> <li>Use natural materials to create a collaborative piece of land art</li> </ul>
