Children will know:

Seasonal Changes

- Name four seasons and identify when in the year they occur.
- Observe and describe weather in different seasons.
- Describe days being longer in summer and shorter in winter.
- Present data in tables charts and compare seasons.

Prior Learning Links:

EYFS - Nursery F1

- Shows curiosity and is interested to explore new and familiar experiences in nature.
- Begins to observe and talk about some of the things they have observed in nature.
- Begins to recognise the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them.

EYFS - Reception F2

- Says what they can hear, see, and feel whilst outside.
- Shows curiosity in the environment around them inside and outdoors.
- Observes and talks about the changes in nature that they notice.
- Starts to talk about changes like the weather/ seasons.
- Names the four seasons and talks about their differences and impact on their lives.
- Understand some important processes and changes in the natural world around them, including the seasons and changing states of matter.

Working Scientifically:

Pupils should be taught to:

- Notice similarities and differences within the seasons.
- Predict what colours are hiding in my leaf.
- Explain what winter feels like.
- Record different signs of spring using labelled diagrams and pictures.
- Evaluate a test by suggesting simple improvements.
- Ask simple questions about what is going on and make careful observations.
