- Suggest appropriate clothing and activities for each season.

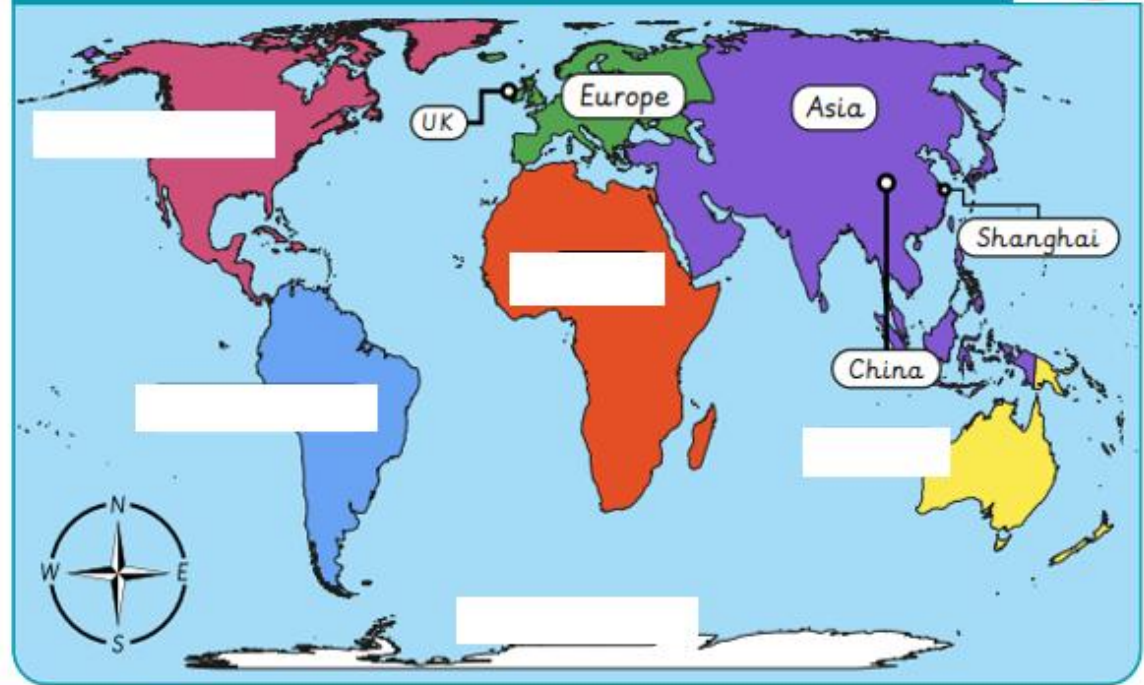
