# NEWSLETTER 01 - 4th September 2019

## Dear Parents/Carers

It was a great pleasure to walk through school this morning and see how quickly the children settled back into class and how happy they all were. If your child is new to school or has just joined the nursery, please feel free to catch me in the playground or come up to the office if you have questions or concerns at any time.

#### WELCOME

Miss Tyrrell has joined us as a Teacher in Willow Class. She has been very busy over the summer holidays and her class room is looking lovely. I am sure she will soon feel part of the team and that everyone will make her feel welcome.

#### WATER BOTTLES & PE KITS

All full time children need to bring a water bottle (tap water only) into school each day. They also need a PE kit at school every day (white t-shirt and black/navy shorts). Please, please, please make sure they have these things in school every day and that all your child's possessions are named. Thank you.

#### BREAKFAST AND LUNCH CLUBS



Don't forget that Breakfast Club is available every morning, at a cost of £3.00, you can bring children from 8:00am. Children in Year 1 and Year 2 who are currently in receipt of free school meals may attend breakfast club for free. Lunch Club is also available from 11.50 - 1.00 pm (am pupils) and 11.15 am

until 1.00 pm (afternoon pupils) at a cost of £2.50 per day with a packed lunch or £4.80 including a school dinner. Pupils taking up 30 hours free childcare can choose to pay for 30 hour lunch club at a cost of £2.00 with a packed lunch or £4.30 including a school dinner.

#### SCHOOL MEALS AND MILK

Laura, our cook, is always happy to support "fussy" eaters, she is careful to ask children if they like gravy etc and nobody will be made to eat anything, so please feel free to encourage your child to give school dinners a try. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a Universal Free School Meal funded by the government.

Please ensure if you haven't already done so that you contact Cool Milk to pay for your child's milk. Their website address is: <a href="www.coolmilk.com">www.coolmilk.com</a> or telephone 0844 854 2913. School will register children as they come into Nursery, however, when your child reaches the age of 5, they are no longer entitled to free milk. School or yourselves should receive a reminder prior to them turning 5. School cannot take payment or resolve milk issues, please contact Cool Milk direct.

## **PAYMENTS**

Please pay for Breakfast Club, Lunch Club and 30 hour Lunch Club in the following way: Payment in full for the following week to be made by the previous Friday, ie. paying on Friday for the following week. You will need to choose packed lunch/school dinners and will not be able to change until the following week. CHILDREN WILL NOT BE ABLE TO STAY UNLESS YOU HAVE PAID IN ADVANCE. Please comply with this to avoid awkward situations for the office staff, if you have a particular difficulty then feel free to come and talk to me.

## FREE SCHOOL MEALS

As you know all full time children are entitled to a universal free school dinner every day. If you think you are in receipt of specific benefits you may qualify for "free school meals". If this is the case school will fund your child's milk, trips and an initial set of school uniform as we get an extra amount of money for each child who registers as being entitled to free school meals. #### **ATTENDANCE**

As most of you are aware, I am no longer allowed to authorise holidays in term time and these will be recorded as unauthorised. Details are in the attendance booklet (copy available on the website). Please continue to complete a holiday form, it helps with Safeguarding if we know where you are! If your child is going to be absent from school or due to arrive later than 9:00am please let us know, preferably before the start of the school day via a telephone call or answer phone message to the office. You can report your child absent as early in the morning as you like as we have an automated answer service. If we don't hear from you Mrs Bower will need to ring/text you before 9:15am. Your anticipated co-operation is greatly appreciated.

#### **APPOINTMENTS**

If you need to make doctors/dentist appointments, please do this at certain times, ie. not at register times, then your child's attendance will remain high. If children miss the register am or pm they are counted as absent for the whole session, however if they register and go at 9:20, for example, they are counted as attending the whole session. The system is strange, I know

but we don't choose it.

#### ASTHMA/MEDICINES



In line with Government regulations we are not allowed to administer medicines in school, unless it is prescribed as 4 times a day. This is the case for all children unless your child's significant medical needs require an Individual Health Care Plan (IHCP) that is written in partnership with Health professionals.

If your child has Asthma and needs an inhaler in school, please collect a Parent Consent Form from Mrs Bower in the office and return this to school as soon as possible.

#### CELEBRATION ASSEMBLIES
