Dear Parents/Carers

SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS

The photographer will be in school on Tuesday 9^{th} March to take individual school photographs. We will ensure that siblings in school have their photographs taken together however due to the current covid climate we won't be able to accommodate older or younger siblings who are not pupils in our school.

EQUIPMENT/UNIFORM
