# READING

Thank you and a huge well done to all of you have been reading with your child everyday since the reading meeting. The teachers are telling me that they have already spotted a difference with some pupils after only a week - keep going the support for the children is brilliant.

# COVID GUIDELINES

As you know we had a staff member test positive recently and we have several pupils who are waiting for PCR tests to come back at the moment. The Government have changed some of the guidelines so please note the following:

- Parents/carers and staff to wear masks at drop off and pick up times.
- Staff to wear masks when not able to keep a 2m distance moving around communal areas in school
- Continue to keep a 2m distance at all times particularly drop off and pick ups.
- Continue to sanitise hands prior to entering school
- Continue to be very mindful of Covid symptoms or potential contact with the virus self isolate and take a PCR test if in any doubt.
- If attending a school event indoors please do a lateral flow test on the morning of the event and do not attend if this is positive or you have any symptoms.
- Please wear a mask if you are coming inside the school building.

We will continue to do everything we possibly can to keep everyone safe and we appreciate your support with this.

As it stands at the moment we are planning to go ahead with our nativity plays but this will require masks and lateral flow tests for families who want to come and watch. I don't like to say it but obviously if cases increase then we will have to look again at our risk assessment – fingers crossed this will not be the case.
