NEWSLETTER 07 - 7th December 2021

Dear Parents/Carers

I wanted to update you on our Covid situation. We currently have 6 children and 1 staff member who have tested positive in Rowan Class and one other child who is still isolating from last week. The percentage of cases in one class requires us to use our Outbreak Plan which puts classes back into bubbles to reduce mixing. These measures include no assemblies, directed areas at playtimes and lunchtimes, no shared clubs etc.

We are doing everything we can in school to keep things as normal for the children and at the same time as safe as possible. We are grateful for your support with wearing masks and taking children home for testing when we ask. It is certainly a big team effort at the moment.

PLEASE CONTINUE TO FOLLOW OUR COVID GUIDELINES

- Parents/carers and staff to wear masks at drop off and pick up times.
- Staff to wear masks when not able to keep a 2m distance moving around communal areas in school.
- Continue to keep a 2m distance at all times particularly drop off and pick ups.
- Continue to sanitise hands prior to entering school.
- Continue to be very mindful of Covid symptoms or potential contact with the virus self isolate and take a PCR test if in any doubt.
- If attending a school event indoors please do a lateral flow test on the morning of the event and do not attend if this is positive or you have any symptoms.
- Please wear a mask if you are coming inside the school building.

NATIVITY PLAYS

Nursery nativity went ahead yesterday and it was lovely. Unless things escalate then we will continue with our plan to perform our nativities in class bubbles (this was always the plan) with just that one set of adults as the audience – this reduces mixing. I will leave it up to you if you invite more vulnerable family members to the performances.

Please note: Borre Wickstrom took photographs of the children in their costumes on Wednesday which will be on sale at the performances. One photograph will cost $\pounds 4$ and two will be $\pounds 6$, with any extras being $\pounds 3$ each.
