# NEWSLETTER 13 - 23.02.2022

Dear Parents/Carers

It has been lovely to see so many children and staff back in school this week - we are almost completely Covid free which is lovely. You may have noticed that Mrs Bower is still absent from work. I know you will join me in sending her our best wishes. This means that there is less office capacity than normal so please continue to put your money in a named envelope so it doesn't get muddled up, we really appreciate your support with this.

#### LIVING WITH COVID

As you will be aware the Government are removing legal requirements relating to covid including the legal requirement to isolate and the expectation that school staff test twice a week. They are still giving advice though! I have copied what I think is the bit of the document that might be most useful, please see below:

Adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people. After 5 days, they may choose to take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) followed by another the next day - if both are negative, and they do not have a temperature, they can safely return to their normal routine. Those who test positive should avoid contact with anyone in an at risk group, including if they live in the same household.

Schools have not been given any specific advice yet so for now I suggest we follow the Government advice and I will update you further when I get information from the Local Authority. I realise that these "living with Covid" plans will evoke different thoughts for different people so if you have any particularly questions please feel free to come and speak to me.

#### DROP OFF AND PICK UP ROUTINES/LATENESS

Thank you to everyone for following the new routines and to the majority of you who are on time for school every day.

It is really, really important that children come to school on time. When children arrive late they miss learning that is happening in the classroom, some feel awkward that they are late and it disrupts learning for everyone which is far from ideal. It also means that office staff (or me!) have to take children to classes which means they are then not available to answer the phone or get on with their work. We realise there are exceptions e.g. sick siblings, car breakdowns etc and these are obviously fine.

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE BE ON TIME FOR SCHOOL - THE GATE OPENS AT 8.40AM AND CLOSES AT 8.50AM.

### PRE-LOVED UNIFORM
