Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been lovely to welcome a new pupil into Oak Class and lots of new children into Nursery. They are all settling in well, making new friends and enjoying their learning. If you are a new parent to school please feel free to come and ask any questions you may have or to clarify things. I am on the playground most mornings or you can come and find me at Reception. It is absolutely fine to ask questions and a worry shared is always easier to solve than one which has been dwelled on.

BREAKFAST CLUB AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

After School Club is up and running and open to all children at a cost of £6 or £9 depending on the length of stay. If you would like to book a place please complete the booking form (emailed previously or in the office).

You may have seen on the news that the Government offers tax free childcare. You have to set up an online Tax Free Childcare account (www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare) and for every £8 you pay in the Government will contribute £2 to pay your childcare provider. As a school we've now set up our details so you can use this for Breakfast Club and After School Club, just search for our school by name. You can then withdraw money to send to school by BACS. If you are planning to do this please contact the office for our bank details and when you've sent money please email the office to tell us how much you've sent and what it is to be used for (eg. Breakfast Club/After School Club) and the dates/times.

You cannot get Tax Free Childcare at the same time as claiming Working Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit, Universal Credit or childcare vouchers.

PE LESSONS

Willow and Rowan classes are enjoying their gymnastic lessons on a Tuesday and Oak class are welcome at the gymnastics after school session. For safety reasons please ensure that your child has their hair tied back on a Tuesday for these lessons.

ASSESSMENTS

Year 2 Assessments will take place in the month of May and the Year 1 Phonics test will take place during week beginning Monday 12th June 2023. These are statutory government assessments which have to take place but we will ensure that they are carried out in a relaxed and happy atmosphere with a drink and a biscuit at the end! **Please do not book holidays during this time**.

Y2 SWIMMING

ADVANCE WARNING: Please be aware that if your child has their ears pierced they will need to have their earings taken out before school on swimming days and if they get them newly pierced and cannot take them out then they will not be allowed to swim - these are Notts School Swimming rules. Y2's will start swimming on Monday 27th February and will swim every Monday until the end of the summer term. Girls have to wear a one piece swimsuit and boys have to wear fitted (speedo type) swimming trunks or shorts - not fabric shorts with pockets. We will send out consent forms nearer the time.
